REPORT OF THE VTU INTER COLLEGIATE YOUTH FESTIVAL (JANANI-2018) HELD AT BKIT, BHALKI FROM 2nd -4th NOVEMBER 2018

The events in which VKITian's participated are: Day-1 [2nd November 2018]






