5.2.2. 1	DVV's observation: [HEI has erroneously categorized various activities as separate events. According to NAAC SOPs, events cannot be fragmented into activities, and multiple activities held closely in time should be treated as one. Additionally, when an organizing institute schedules different activities, such as Volleyball in the first month and Table Tennis in the middle of the year, they should be viewed as a single event due to their similar level, such as zonal or state, despite the temporal time-gap. Thus, no additional benefits should be granted for the temporal time-gap between these activities, which is inevitable in managing activities.
